Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

I hope you and your family have been enjoying a restful summer break. As we prepare to welcome our students and staff back to school in the coming days I would like to take this opportunity to share with you some updates and reminders.

You may have noticed lots of building activity around our school site during the summer break. The installation of our new modular buildings, to replace the existing "k" prefabricated building, is nearing completion. We are looking forward with great excitement to moving in the coming weeks to these impressive, state of the art facilities. We also warmly welcome the addition to Teaching & Learning at PCS of purpose-built specialist rooms, within the new building, where students joining our new ASD class will be based.

Access to the school site will continue to be restricted to pedestrians, cyclists and staff vehicles only. Drop off and/or collection of students is not permitted within the school grounds. We are very grateful for the overwhelming support that this traffic-free site initiative has received from parents since its introduction last year. The safety of all members of the school community using the site has improved as a result of this move.

Electric/motorised bikes or scooters are not permitted in the school grounds for health and safety reasons.

We continue to encourage students to walk, cycle or use public transport for their school journeys. Please be mindful of local residents' access if you are parking, however briefly, along neighbouring residential roads for school purposes. Traffic management measures including double yellow lines are in place and should be observed by all members of our school community.

The return schedule for each year group is below. Students should go directly to the assembly hall at the arrival time for their year group. Full school uniform including shoes (not runners) should be worn. Non- uniform jackets are not permitted. Students are expected to observe the School Appearance Policy in full at all times. Please refer to the policies section on the school website to avoid any confusion upon returning next week. We appreciate the ongoing support of parents in ensuring the continued high standards of uniform and appearance of our students.

Arising from consultation with the Parents Association, students and staff last term, we will be introducing a PE uniform across all year groups in the course of

the first half-term. The designs, as selected by the students, consist of a PE top and a choice of tracksuit bottoms as well as optional extra items e.g. shorts. Production and supply issues have delayed the availability of the PE top and bottoms. When we have confirmation of availability of the items to order we will update you. In the meantime we urge parents not to spend unnecessarily on expensive items of sportswear for school purposes. We hope that stock availability will enable all students to have purchased the PE top (€34.95-39.95 depending on size) and *one* of the options for P.E. trousers (also €35 approxprices differ for each style) by the first day back after the mid-term break, on Monday 7th November. The P.E. uniform will offer a cost-effective and practical solution to escalating sportswear costs and peer pressure issues, as reflected in our discussions with all partners in our school community. Families for whom this change presents a financial challenge should, as always, contact the Principal in complete confidence.
